Hi Jason:

In response to the Municipality's letter of August 10, 2022 outlining their concerns, I would like to propose the following:

1. Traffic study

Toivo Rukholm, P.Eng. of Tranplan Associates has committed to carry out a **Traffic Impact Study** next spring since his existing workload would not allow him to do the work this fall.

2. Blast Notification

Since this not an ARA Standard, we will not be adding to the site plan and in the past MNR would not put something on the site plan that they could not enforce.

Notification Process – draft sample letter (that will explain the process) that will be placed in mailboxes to collect information.

Dear Resident:

This notice has been placed in neighboring mail boxes requesting the e-mail address for those residents who would like to receive advance notification of upcoming blasts.

The Licensee will attempt to follow this process:

- *Approximately 1 week before the anticipated blast, an e-mail will be sent out indicating that there will be an upcoming blast*
- *An e-mail will be sent out the day before the blast with an indication as to when the blast will occur, subject to operational conditions*
- *Hopefully we can arrange for posting on the Municipal website and/or Facebook page*

If you would like to be placed on the List for Advanced Notification, please forward you e-mail address ASAP to: _____

If you know of someone who does not have a mail box along the road, would you mind passing this Notice on to them

If you do not have an e-mail address, please arrange with a friend or neighbor to keep you informed.

3. Complaint protocol

Since this not an ARA Standard, we will not be adding to the site plan and in the past MNRF would not put something on the site plan that they could not enforce.

There are two scenarios for addressing complaints: those related to what occurs within the Licence boundary and those that occur outside the boundary.

- Those within the boundary

If there is a concern with any activity within the boundary, then the concerned individual can contact the Licensee and/or the appropriate Ministry or Agency under whose mandate the concern would fall.

- Those outside the boundary

If the concern is related to an activity outside the boundary, then the individual should contact the Municipality and/or the appropriate Ministry or Agency under whose mandate the concern would fall.

If these concerns have been addressed to your satisfaction, could you please send me a letter confirming this as I will have to provide MNRF with confirmation that your concerns have been addressed.
